Subject: 5th Grade Baby Photos and Sentiments

The DES Yearbook includes two special sections featuring fifth grade students: (1) Baby Pictures and (2) Sentiments.

First, parents can submit a baby picture of their child to appear in the yearbook. It is fun for the children to try to guess which baby has grown into which DES 5th grade student! Fifth grade baby photos will be featured in a special section of the yearbook.

Second, parents can submit a current photo of their child (photos should be from a camera, not an iPhone because iPhone photos haven't transferred very well in the past) along with a sentiment congratulating their student and wishing him/her well.

Baby photos and sentiments are both free of charge and uploaded to the yearbook website. **They are due on or before December 1st.**

The instructions to upload a current photo with Sentiments and Baby Pictures are as follows:

1. Go to www.yearbookforever.com
2. Type in "Davidsonville Elementary School" (If the link doesn't take you there, check your web browser. There is currently a glitch when using Google Chrome, so try Internet Explorer or Firefox web browser if you have problems with the link)
3. Click the "Community Upload" button on the upper right hand side of the screen.
4. Enter the access code: "gators" (all lower case)
5. Click "Upload Photo" and select the current Sentiment photo from your computer. Select "Yearbook Special Requests" as the category in the pull down list. Be sure to include your student's first and last name and sentiment message in the "Add a note" section.
Sentiment text can be no more than 15 words, including signatures.
Example: Congratulations Mary! We are so proud of you. Love, Mom, Dad & Sammy
6. Click the next "Upload Photo" and locate the BABY Picture from your computer. Select "Baby Pictures (Not For Ads)" as the category in the pull down list. Be sure to include your student's first and last name in the "Add a note" section so we know who the child is.
7. Next, enter YOUR contact information in the event that the yearbook staff needs to contact you. Select the check box which states you agree that the photos can be used for the yearbook. Click "Submit Photos".

Reminder - Don't forget to order the yearbook before December 1st!!
