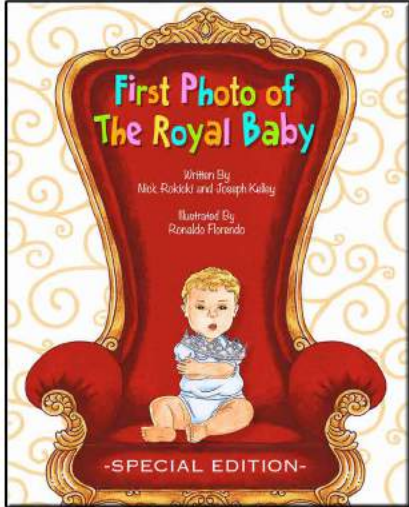


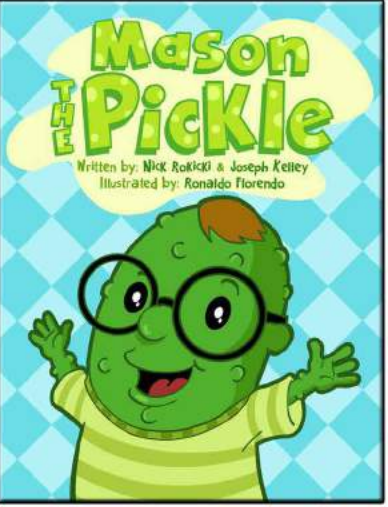

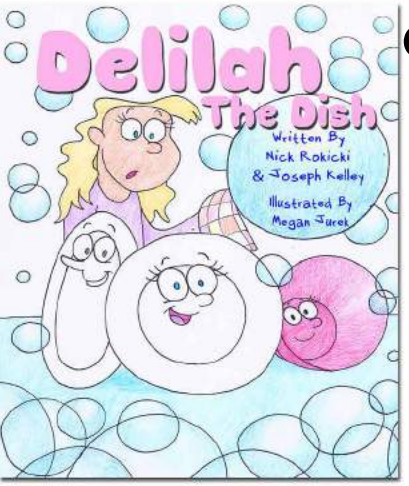
First Photo of the Royal Baby is our youngest reader, teaching babies reading through repetition. The lesson? Smile! You never know who is watching!

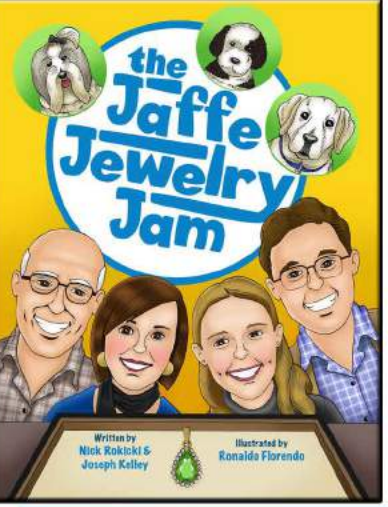
Mason the Pickle is the perfect pick-me-up for children who are feeling lonely or those that have a unique trait that makes them different. Mason learns about the things that make him great!

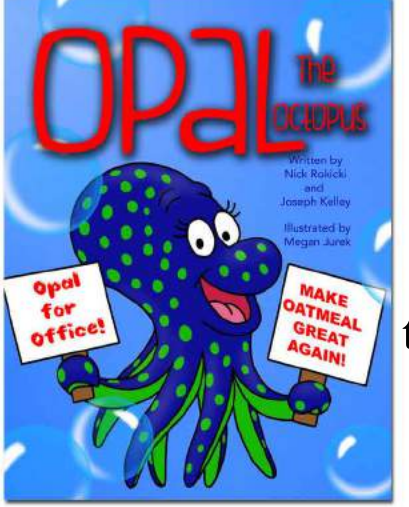
Cleanliness and chores are the lessons in Delilah the Dish. This story is perfect for children around 2nd Grade!

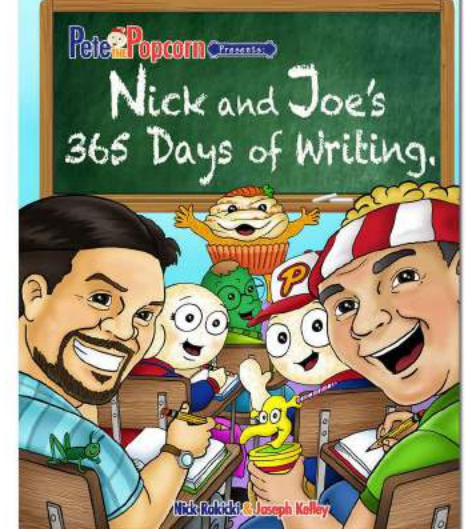

Opal the Octopus is running for office at Oceanic Orphanage. She doesn't like the orange oatmeal! This tongue-twisting vocab builder is fun!

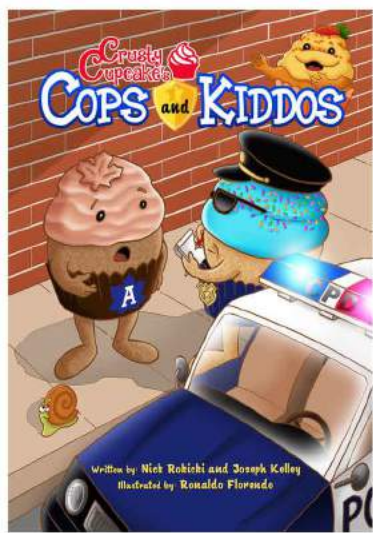

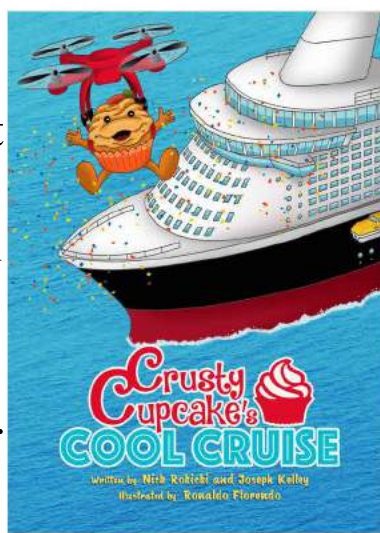
